Bylaw 524-20 Hussar & Palliser Intermunicipal Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (ISDAB)

Purpose: Village of Hussar wishes to join other area municipalities to establish the Palliser ISDAB. It is authorized to render decisions on appeals resulting from decisions of a Subdivision Authority or a Development Authority in accordance with the Municipal Government Act (MGA), the Subdivisions and Development Regulation, the local Land Use Bylaw and statutory plans.

Bylaw 525-20 Hussar & Wheatland Intermunicipal Development Plan (IDP)

Purpose: The Village of Hussar and Wheatland County have a history of collaboration and cooperation. This IDP builds on this past collaboration and sets the groundwork for continued joint planning for lands around the Village as identified by the IDP Area.

2020 UTILITY RATES

Utility rates for water will be increasing for 2020.

Garbage and Sewer rates will remain the same

Monthly Utility Billing: \$120.00

Annual Utility Billing: \$1440.00

HOW TO PAY YOUR BILL.....

If you are struggling to remember to pay your bill on a monthly basis, we can help! The Village has more than one option to pay your bills.

- Drop off post-dated cheques. The Village will automatically process these cheques. (These cheques can be for both utilities and taxes.)
- Switch to annual billing. With annual billing you can pay once for the entire year. (There is no cost savings by paying monthly or annually.)
- Pay by interact e-transfer through online banking. Please contact the Village Office for more information on e-transfer requirements.

MONTHLY TAX PAYMENTS

Would you like to pay your taxes monthly? Here's how:

1. From your 2019 Tax Notice: Divide the total 2019 tax amount by 12.
2. Write 6 cheques for the amount calculated, date one for each month (January to June) for any day of your choosing. (This is essentially pre-paying your taxes for half a year).
3. Drop off the cheques at the Village Office.

What happens next:

4. The cheques will be processed on the date written and deposited with the next regular bank deposit.
5. When your 2020 Tax Notice is received complete the above process using the total 2020 tax amount and dating the cheques for July to December.

Why this is a good option:

- You are able to better budget monthly for tax payments.
- As long as you have been making monthly payments you will not be charged penalties on unpaid taxes as of July 31st of each year.
- You will have completely paid your taxes by December 31st of each year so will not be charged penalties.

Please note: You may make the cheques out for any amount of your choosing, however, any amount unpaid at December 31st will be charged penalties.

If you choose to combine your monthly tax payment with your monthly utility payment, please indicate this on your cheques. The Village will automatically use the cheque to pay the full outstanding utility amount and then pay the remaining amount to taxes.
