Policy Statement

This policy has been adopted to provide guidelines for the transfer of outstanding garbage service fees to the property tax roll.

General Guidelines

All garbage collection service fees that are over sixty (60) days past due will be added to the tax roll for the property. Yearly mortgagee accounts will be transferred prior to tax assessment notices being sent.

Garbage collection fees will be transferred to the tax roll of the property at the same time as overdue utility accounts are transferred and following the guidelines as laid out in Policy 7.1 Outstanding Utility Account Transfer to Tax Roll.

The amount of garbage collection fees to be transferred will be included in the overdue amount provided in the notification to the property owner as per Policy 7.1 Outstanding Utility Account Transfer to Tax Roll.
