Dear Residents and Property Owners of the Village of Hussar,

The viability review conducted by the province for the Village of Hussar and the mandated work of the Village of Hussar Viability Review Team (VRT) is now complete. Information regarding the Municipal Sustainability Strategy, the viability review process, and the Village of Hussar Viability Review Plan (distributed to village residents in June 2018) may be found on the Municipal Affairs website at: [www.municipalaffairs.gov.ab.ca/viability-reviews](http://www.municipalaffairs.gov.ab.ca/viability-reviews).

Based on the information in the Village of Hussar Viability Review Plan prepared by the VRT, along with the input received from the public and the Village of Hussar after the release of the plan, I have made the decision that the Village of Hussar will remain as a municipality at this time.

To ensure the village implements the necessary changes to achieve viability, I have directed the village council and administration to take actions to ensure the viability of the village. The village is directed to develop an action plan as to how council will address each recommendation in the viability plan, to develop a long-term infrastructure plan, and to report to my ministry over a five-year period on the progress of the plans.
